## Applications

---

The VIM5 monoclonal antibody binds with human CD87, a 36 - 68 kD transmembrane protein often located on the surface of granulocytes and keratinocytes. CD87 is associated with a variety of biologically interesting macromolecules/ligands, in particular, Pro-UPA. CD87 is a relatively rare antibody target, with fewer than 400 publications in the last decade. Even still, CD87 has been widely used in immunology research, typically serving as a phenotypic marker for differentiating cell types in flow cytometric applications. This antibody was purified through affinity chromatography and conjugated to PE/XFD700 (ex/em = 566/721 nm). XFD700 is manufactured by AAT Bioquest, and it has a chemical structure similar to that of Alexa Fluor® 700 (Alexa Fluor® is the trademark of Thermo Fisher). It is compatible with the 561 nm laser and 720/60 nm bandpass filter (for example, as in the Bio-Rad ZE5 Cell Analyzer).
