Applications

The H4A3 monoclonal antibody binds with human/ non-human primates/ mouse CD107a, a 45 kD transmembrane protein frequently expressed on the surface of macrophages, endothelial cells, epithelial cells and activated platelets. CD107a is associated with a variety of biologically interesting macromolecules/ligands, for example, . CD107a is a fairly uncommon antibody target, with a little more than 4600 publications in the last decade. Even still, CD107a is often used in flow cytometry applications as a phenotypic marker for differentiation of cell types, particularly in the study of immunology and neuroscience. This antibody was purified through affinity chromatography and conjugated to XFD555 (ex/em = 553/568 nm). XFD555 is manufactured by AAT Bioquest, and it has a chemical structure similar to that of Alexa Fluor® 555 (Alexa Fluor® is the trademark of Thermo Fisher). It is compatible with the 561 nm laser and 586/20 nm bandpass filter (for example, as in the Agilent Technologies NovoCyte Quanteon).
